Leaving Monmouth on A40 towards Abergavenny turn left on to B4293 towards Chepstow. Keep on B4293 for 3 miles after the old Toll House. Turn left to Penalt and Whitebrook and the left fork to Penalt. You will pass Ty Mawr convent on your right. Drive past this entrance to the next gates on the right which lead into Michaelgarth.
